Co-created with a Global Patient Advisory Board, the Patient Advocacy Leadership Collective is an innovative hub that provides connectivity, community resources, and tools focused on sustainable capacity building for patient advocates globally, subject to local laws, regulations and industry codes.

The mission of the Patient Advocacy Leadership Collective is to support patient advocacy organizations around the world by empowering them with knowledge and skills through offering evidence-based tools and resources that elevate their work in support of patient communities. The platform offers programs and resources focused on supporting the growth, development, and leadership of patient advocacy organizations to deliver upon their mission to support patients and their families. It should be noted that *certain support services under PALC are only available in select regions.*

The Patient Advocacy Leadership Collective Programs

Supporting Organizational Growth	The <u>NextGen Leadership Program</u> is curated by a global faculty of patient advocacy organization leaders, with input from over 170 patient advocates in 35 countries. Courses are focused on building skills in business leadership, communication, and knowledge about public health and research.
Connecting Advocacy Professionals	The <u>Mentor Match Program</u> connects people working in patient advocacy roles for the purposes of establishing a mentoring relationship. Once established, your mentoring relationship will be managed between you and your mentoring partner, independent of this matching service.
Sharing Resources and Knowledge	The <u>Global Health Fellows (GHF) Program</u> * places Pfizer colleagues on skills-sharing assignments with global health organizations to help strengthen local health systems.
